# Croning – Am I Ready?

From a UU World publication, the following is paraphrased: In pagan traditions, women's lives were divided into three phases: Maiden, Mother, and Crone. Croning is the ceremony in which women celebrate the end of their years as Mother (which may or may not have involved the raising of children) and the arrival of old age and wisdom. When a woman becomes a Crone "she lets go of mothering and perhaps fears she may have of aging. Her energies are now directed towards spiritual goals, healing, guiding, teaching, and being a living model for girls and women."

These three phases of our life can be viewed as the waxing, full, and waning moon. The Maiden is our youth, our coming into Being. The Maiden represents a promise of new beginnings, youth, excitement, and being carefree. The Mother is an actual mothering time or a nurturing time for what we feel we can contribute to. The Mother represents ripeness, fulfillment, stability, and power. The Mother Goddess can represent wellspring of life in all its forms, giving, and compassion. To become a Crone, one decides, regardless of a specific age, that she is ready to move on to the time of wisdom and sharing, leaving the attractions of youth behind and moving on to more etheric goals. The Crone represents wisdom, repose, and compassion and openly sharing who she's become with others.

Having decided to go through the croning ceremony with my UU Connection sisters at a fall retreat several years ago, I can share that I felt a profound shift in my energy – the energy moving from deep nurturing (did not involve raising children), to a lightening but deeper opening to slowing down, sinking deeper into the "mystery" and beginning to release my former involvement with "Mother". My ceremony was meaningful to me but we've held another since mine where the participants shared something significant to them that they felt called them to the croning ceremony. At our retreats, we may not always do the same type of ceremony but what's more important is your own personal commitment to become a Crone.

There's no urgency to become a Crone – ever – but when you feel so called, listen to that beautiful and wise voice.

#### Faux Batik with Flour Paste Resist – with Jenny Ross

Create your own patterned fabric using flour paste resist, stencils, and a limited number of colors of thickened dye. Materials will be provided to experiment with this fun technique on pieces of white cotton fabric. You are welcome to bring your own items to dye – they must be cotton, silk or a blend of the two and prewashed without fabric softener. There will be a materials fee of \$10, payable at the retreat. Some additional items to dye will be available for sale at the retreat.

#### Matchbox Altars - with Sage Hagy

Create your own portable sacred space using matchboxes and a variety of art supplies. Create a shrine to a Goddess, a space to hold small sacred objects, a memorial, or anything else you can imagine. There will be plenty of art supplies available but you are welcome to bring your own and your own small sacred objects.
